

Comment on Infectious diseases Situation from 2012-2017

- No case of Dangerous Flu (H5N1), (H7N9) and Cholera.
- No outbreak in other infectious diseases. Some case of Encephalitis VR and Meningitis.
- In 2015-2016, Typhoid fever re-occurred in Dakrong District with 48 cases.
- No case of Measles within 3 years (2011-2013), but 33 cases of Measles recorded in 2014 (raising upon whole country situation), No case of Measles recorded from 2015 to now.
- Denger Fever: Number of cases of 6 six first months in 2017 decrease 27,14% compared with the same period last year.
- Malaria rises significantly and trends to continue to rise in coming time.

SUGGESTION

- 1. Continued to coordinate between the health units in the province, especially in the border districts for controlling infectious disease.
- 2. Develop Information exchange system (coordinate in MBDS). Regularly sharing health information between 3 provinces.
- 3. Coordinate medical quarantine at two border gates (Lao Bao Savavnnakhet), particularly implemented SWI/SSI
- 4. Development and implement of Website Health MQS.
